Spiritualism in The Modern World Part 3 by Elaine Rhodes**The 7 Principles of Spiritualism:**

Let us go through them briefly, The Fatherhood of God, is compatible with I should think all the religions of the world, so we need not go into that any further.

The Brotherhood of Man:

Would seem to any thinking person of reasonable intelligence, to be a logical step from the idea of the fatherhood of God, since if God made us all, then we are all his children, and therefore brothers and sisters in the eyes of God. This one principle however seems to be a stumbling block to some people, with a particular example being that of Apartheid in South Africa. Though I would hasten to add, that it is not the only one it must surely be the most well-known example of man's wrong thinking. God in his wisdom made mankind in varying shades of colour, shapes and sizes. It was very definitely not given to man, to consider that any one race or colour was any better than any other. A mother does not love one child more than another, simply because one has eyes blue or brown, or that one has fair hair or dark, each child is special to her and has special qualities for her, just so with God and his love of his earthly children, we each one are precious and have our own individual redeeming features. This being the case, we should surely see that we ought to accept one another, and learn to love our brothers and sisters in the eyes of God.

The Communion of Spirits and the Ministry of Angels:

Is not so difficult to understand or equate with the other major religions of the world, if we remember that Jesus, Moses, Buddha, the list is endless, all had communion with spirit from whence they had inspirational guidance and words of wisdom to impart to the world, upon which man built these so called religions, each one of which teaches us that life continues, even after so called death.

Personal responsibility:

Is self-explanatory but not something that many people are prepared to accept, it is much easier is it not, to believe that another can take responsibility for our weakness and or sin. Yet in our everyday lives, most people would agree that having raised our children to adulthood, we can no longer be held responsible for their every action. Why then can they not accept that equally no other person, whosoever they may be, can take responsibility for our sins. We each one have to be responsible for ourselves and answerable to God for them. There is no way that the forgiveness of the person or persons we have sinned against can remove the plain and simple fact that we did sin. If I do a malicious act, let's say for arguments sake, that I take an ornament belonging to someone else and deliberately or to otherwise break that ornament, does not alter the fact that I broke it. Let us take that argument a stage further, if I do harm to another human being, part of God's creation, then I am answerable to God for my actions, and no-one can do that for me, in other words there can be no one who can take responsibility for me or do penance on my behalf. If that were the case we would result surely in an attitude that we could do whatever we liked, as long as someone else took the blame. Spiritualists therefore believe that there is no way of escaping the results of our actions.

Compensation and Retribution hereafter for all the good and evil deeds done on earth:

Well we have just been discussing that. We believe that when we make that change that we call death, we each have to answer for our every action good or bad, and be compensated or have to atone for them.

Eternal Progress Open to every Human Soul:

i.e we are each one of us on a spiritual journey and as we develop in spiritual awareness and understanding so we progress to a higher state of consciousness.

So we see do we not, that to be a spiritualist is to accept responsibility for our every action, thought word and deed, and accepting the above principles as a recipe for living, we see that we have to learn to live together in peace and tolerance, accepting that there are differences, but that each nationality, each individual has something to contribute of value.

Let us go back to the subject of communion of spirit, we believe that through the use of a medium, we can have communion with those of our loved ones in the Spirit World, who want us to know that life is continuous. They also tell us that we must learn to love and tolerate one another. There is nothing very strange about that, it is a perfectly natural sequence of life, one which has gone on for as long man as himself.

Jesus came back and showed himself in the spirit so that his followers would know him and be able to understand what he had been telling them when in the body, that we are of spirit, from spirit we came and to spirit we will return. He taught his disciples (who were sensitive's) how to have communion with spirit and accept the teachings given from them, and greatest of theses, and the most fundamental was that we should all learn to love one another.

When man can learn to do that, then and only then will we have peace on all the earth. We pray in our churches and our homes that the heads of government and states will be imbued with the wisdom to make the right decisions concerning their fellow men. That man's inhumanity to man may cease, and that where there is bigotry and greed it may be removed. For we know that the salvation of man, lies with man himself.

So to those critics who would say that we are being deceived and taken in by the devil, I cannot see what the devil, if he exists, would have to gain from exhorting us to love one another as brothers and sisters, to treat others as we would have them treat us and to accept that we are all part of Gods creations of mankind and equal in his sight, since supposedly the devil is the very opposite of all that is good, whose very existence is to cause as much disruption possible and to claim our soul from God our creator.

A much more logical reason for those critics to say this, would be because they see that the principles of Spiritualism and the fundamental truths expounded by them releases men from the shackles of ignorance, allowing them to know that they need a mediator to act on their behalf, and that each individual is responsible for his or her own destiny.

Such knowledge and understanding once and for all times sets us free from the need of or threats of so called religious leaders, and remove from us forever the fear of death and dying, the scales of ignorance removed we accept life for what it is, but a miniscule part of a life which goes on for all eternity.
